



As of today, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor has issued an emergency order that will last for a month. Governor Evers has ordered Wisconsin residents to stay at home, with limited exceptions, and prohibited gatherings with people outside of one's household. And as you know, the pandemic is forcing many voters to use absentee, mail-in ballots, some for the first time in their lives.

Unfortunately, the pandemic and the Governor's order will make it impossible for Wisconsin voters to obtain a witness signature on their mail-in absentee ballot from an adult United States citizen, if there is no such person in their household.
